


The examiners may expect candidates to show knowledge of legislation which is in place but not in force, i.e., has been enacted and regulations which have been made which are not yet in force if they are directly relevant to the subject-matter of the examination.



Closed Book Examinations

Does not allow candidates to take into the examination room any other materials than pens/pencils/erasures/highlighters and candidate exam card information in a clear packet.

Candidates taking the Weights and Measures Practical examination, you **may** take into the exam a self-contained non-programmable calculator.

Extenuating Circumstances

If you have any circumstances (health or personal) that may affect your performance in the lead up to or on the day of your exam(s).

Photo Identification

All candidates are required to bring with them photo identification to **ALL** examinations being taken.

This must be presented to the person in charge of the examination when signing your attendance at the exam.
