L6 Trading Standards Professional Apprenticeship (L6 TSP) Transition Information

This guidance is for L6 TSP apprentices wishing to transition into the Qualifications Framework (QF), alongside completing their Level 6 apprenticeship.

There are two options available. These are detailed below.

Option 1 – to be awarded the Trading Standards Practitioner Diploma (Stage 2) of the QF. After you have completed the first year of your apprenticeship you can apply to transition into Stage 2 of the QF alongside completion of your L6 apprenticeship (see Stage 2 transition information below).

Option 2 – FSA endorsed recognition of Food/Feed unit.

Apprentices who wish to finalise their food/feed unit status, will be required to submit their Food/Feed coursework and undertake a CTSI oral assessment. (See Food / Feed individual unit transition).

Registration Process & Guidance:

- Candidates should arrange a purchase order number with your finance team, for the cost of the transition.
- Use the provided purchase order number to register your place via the online booking page.
- Enter all details required to ensure a smooth process.

- A registration confirmation letter will be sent from the CTSI Education Team once the booking has been processed fully.
- Details of the examination cycle week commencement dates are available on the <u>Exam cycle information</u> tab on the website.

- Candidates need a Microsoft account (this can be either your work account or a personal Microsoft account). This will be required for your portfolio and coursework requirements.

 Candidates will be required to upload their coursework and or portfolio content submissions into their SharePoint file by the required deadline based on the examination

These package fees are for a candidate to complete all required examinations and training at a discounted rate.

Candidates will be able to complete these elements over a 4-year period to be awarded the Trading Standards Practitioner Diploma (TSPD).

Dates and Deadlines

Candidates transitioning will be adhering to the QF dates and deadlines set by CTSI.

Portfolio and coursework submissions for review will need to be uploaded into the dedicated SharePoint folder by the following deadlines:

*Candidates must have submitted their corresponding portfolio and any coursework required by the deadline, for entry to the Professional Interview, Practical and/or Oral assessments. When sitting the weights and measures practical, oral and professional interview assessments for the first time, these must be sat together in the first exam cycle.

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Food / Feed individual unit transition

Costs: £450+vat (per subject)

As part of the L6 Trading Standards Practitioner Apprenticeship, CTSI will be conducting an audit of coursework a candidate has submitted for their Food / Feed elements of the apprenticeship.

CTSI will be administering and assessing the oral examination which you will sit as part of the Food / Feed qualification.

Dates and Deadlines

Candidates will need to provide the details of the coursework being submitted for review, the date of submission and in which examination cycle they wish to take the oral assessment as part of the registration process.

Candidates transitioning into the QF will be adhering to the QF dates and deadlines set. This includes the training dates available.

Apprenticeship Coursework submissions for review will need to be uploaded into the dedicated file by the following deadlines. Please note, if coursework is not submitted, you will be unable to sit the Oral examination and be automatically moved to the next exam cycle.

Coursework submissions will be reviewed by the examiner and moderator and feedback will be provided where applicable. A resubmission, if needed, will be given a 2-week deadline from the date of response.

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Additional Information

Candidates will in addition be able to complete both options at alternative stages, using the Food/Feed transition & L6 as an exemption from Stage 2. The fee of the Food/Feed package will be discounted from the Stage 2 package fee.

Important Information for Apprentices

It is recommended that apprentices transition into the framework at the earliest opportunity once the food or feed elements/training has been completed with the CSA. These transition options apply to apprentices taking either the two-year or three-year training route. There is no requirement for an apprentice to have fully completed their apprenticeship first to be able to transition into the CTSI Qualifications Framework.

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
