Stage 2: Unit 4 Weights and Measures Reflective Statement Examiner Report November 2025

A total of 18 candidates submitted their weights and measures reflective statement in this cohort.

It was nice to see a variety of activities covered in the statements, including some of our more routine work. Not every activity has to be a complicated piece of kit. In most cases the tasks were well reflected upon. There was little mention of the regulatory/services objectives etc in the write up. The marking scheme does refer to this. I appreciate it is challenging given the paucity of opportunities trainees are exposed to, but a bit more in this area would have improved marks. The task refers to an activity, not a collection of activities. The visit/complaint etc should be sufficient to reflect upon without need for adding an additional visit on. Please remember to use appropriate referencing in the write up.

When completing the reflective statement for this subject, candidates are reminded to check the criteria requirements and looking at where the weighting of marks sit and focusing accordingly. We advise candidates to also review the guidance available.
