Stage 2: Weights and Measures Reflective Statement Coursework Examiner's Report May 2026

Eleven submissions for this examination round were of a generally very good account of reflection of the scenario.

There does seem to be a narrow pool of tasks that are undertaken (PGR, NAWI and LFMI) and it would be nice to see some of the more technical equipment/scenarios that Inspectors have to deal with now and again being discussed.

Candidates are successfully identifying that there is a vast chasm between the learnings in a classroom and reality and that the skills required are not just metrology related but in dealing with situations and the human element which can impact upon a satisfactory intervention.

The higher marks were obtained by those who identified what future development is needed, whether soft skills, logistics or better exposure to the metrology functions of their authority. Higher marks were also awarded where Health and Safety risks assessments were considered necessary and/or requirements for food/feed/health establishments.
