You will participate in the work of the Yorkshire and Humber Authorities Verification Service, ensuring compliance with MID requirements, and the regional metrology focus group. You and your team will contribute to national and regional metrology projects as well as devising intelligence led inspection programmes for North Yorkshire, such as a current project testing LFMLs on canals and inland waterways.

You will manage officers undertaking criminal and civil investigations, primarily involving fair trading and product safety matters, and will liaise with the financial investigations team to ensure that the Proceeds of Crime Act is used in appropriate cases to recover criminal benefit. You will contribute to the legal process of prosecution files, including appearing in the magistrates' court on behalf of the Service to present guilty plea cases and to attend preliminary hearings.
