Stage 3 Project Examiner and Moderator
Roles

Two roles within the CTSI Professional Competency Framework qualification as a Project Examiner or Moderator are available. These roles will examine students for the **Trading Standards Advanced Practitioner (Degree Level)** award. On completion of this award, students can apply for the Chartered Trading Standards Practitioner status. You will have a wide range of knowledge and experience, and can work under pressure and to set deadlines.

Minimum requirements needed:

- a minimum of 5 years' experience at a managerial level and is a CTSP or willing to work towards CTSP within 12 months of appointment;
- hold a valid trading standards qualification (DCATS, DCA, DTS (and antecedents));
- time management skills;
- attention to detail;
- commitment to delivery on the requirement of the competency framework throughout the year as required; and
- intermediate level of IT skills to be used with systems in the new qualification.
