

How to use the RDNA tool

Step 1

Go to the link http://rdna-tool.bis.gov.uk/

Step 2

On the screen with which you are presented, login using the login details for your account, or click 'Register' if you do not have an account.



If you are unsure whether you have an account, click 'Forgotten password' and follow the onscreen instructions.

On the login screen you will also see the 'RDNA self-assessment tool user guide'. This will help you make the most of the tool.

Step 3

Once you are logged in, select the section in which you wish to carry out your self-assessment. For the purposes of creating this guide, the 'Food' area will be used as an example:
