Travelling to BEIS	Check out the location map on the web site and links to www.streetmap.co.uk http://www.transportforlondon.gov.uk/buses/index.shtml Teddington is our nearest railway station, about 12 minutes away Coming in on the M3 or M4 or across London can take a lot longer than you think in the extended London rush hour 7:45-9:30
Accommodation in the area	Its South West London and near to Heathrow so the hotels are not cheap. However there are a lot of smaller B&Bs in the area, but book up early. A seven mile radius would include Kingston, Twickenham, Surbiton, Sunbury, Hampton and others.
Food	Tesco in the high street (out gate turn right 3mins) Sainsbury on the Uxbridge Road (by car turn left 7 mins) Restaurants and take aways in Teddington high street
Car Parking	NOT on the NMRO site as there is very limited parking available. Street parking close to the gate in Blandford or Connaught roads Out gate left and left again or left out of gate immediate right and left again.
Public Transport	Trains: The station is Teddington in Adelaide Road check the link below. The mainline London Station is Waterloo details of timetable and layout of station on the railtrack website http://www.nationalrail.co.uk/stations/ted/details.html Bus: Bus to Heathrow is number 285, ask at NMRO reception for local bus routes Taxi: Parka Cars 0208 979 7777
Security	As a government building we have certain security requirements. On the day you will be sent round to NMRO by the gatehouse. You will have to register your attendance with the CTSI administrators. If you leave the site you must inform the CTSI representatives so we maintain accurate records of who is in the building
Smoking?	Smoking is not permitted in the building. However there are designated areas on the grounds.
Cash machines	All on the high street Halifax Link 3 mins, Barclays before bridge 6 mins, Nat West over bridge 8 mins.

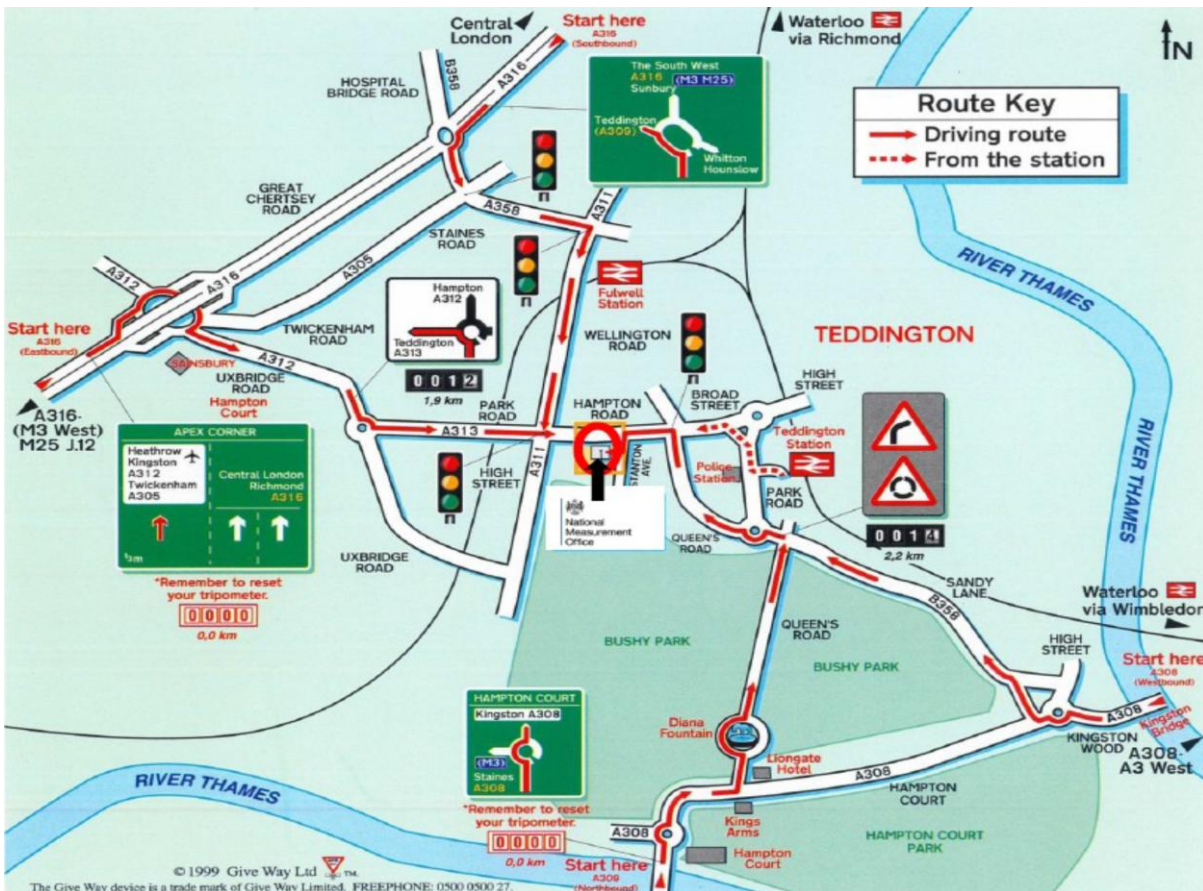
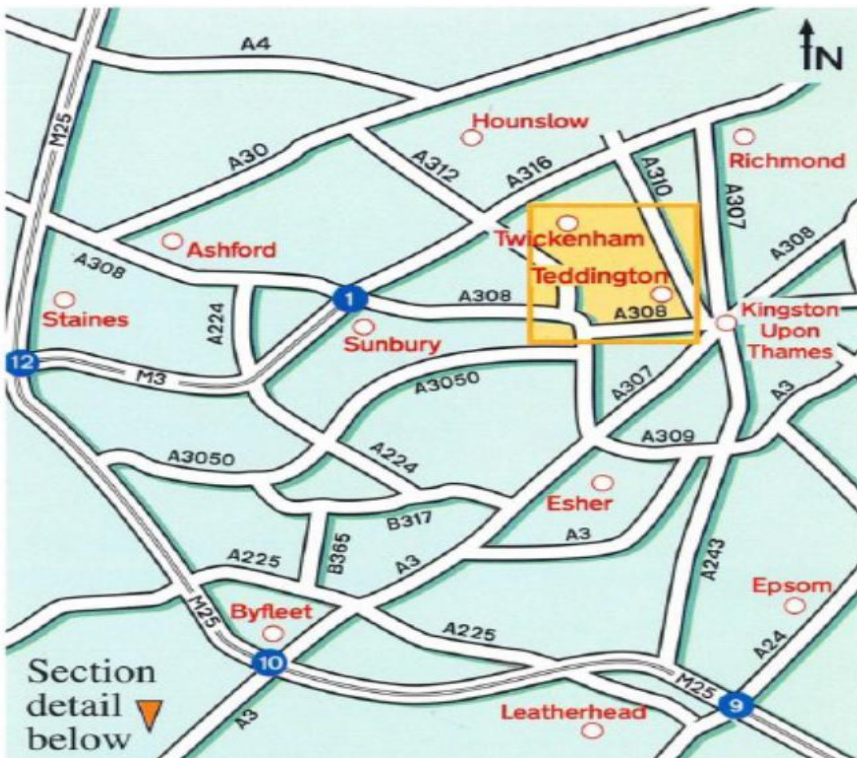
NB. If you have both Legal Metrology and Food or Agriculture examination TSI will transfer you between the venues by the TSI company car.

Visitor's information:

All visitors must enter Stanton Avenue via the Hampton Road gate which is immediately adjacent to the NMO building. Please speak to the Security Officer at the gate who will direct you accordingly. Please look at the maps above for directions. **The Queens Road entrance is open to site or visitor pass holders only.**

Driving to NMO:

Please be aware that NMO shares the Teddington site with other laboratories and parking spaces are available for visitors. The Security Officer will direct you to the NPL reception where you will receive instructions for parking. Please note that the roads on the site can be busy. NMO has limited visitor parking and if this is full you may be directed to a large car park which is a 5 minute walk back to NMO. We suggest that you regularly check this page for the latest situation on parking facilities.

Rail services, Teddington from Waterloo:

Exit the station on the ticket office side. Turn right and continue up the road. Take a right then proceed to the roundabout. Turn left and continue to walk along Broad Street for approximately ten minutes, passing Tesco's on your left. Continue past the main set of traffic lights and Stanton Avenue is the second turning on the left. Please check in with security.
