

REGULATORY LEADERS PROGRAMME

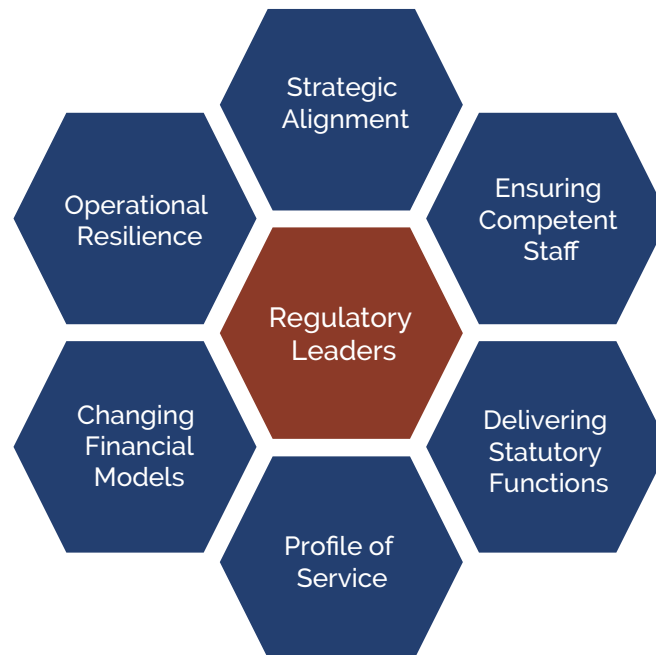
Our programme is designed specifically for regulatory professionals to give them the confidence to lead their teams, develop their wider leadership skills and help them learn how to influence and inspire others.

Why have you developed a programme specifically for regulatory leaders?

As a group of regulatory professionals, we are passionate about the important role regulatory services play in delivering services to local communities and businesses.

We have experience in wider public services leadership so also understand some of the challenges that regulatory services face compared to other services and felt it was important to focus on leadership development in these areas.

We recognise the importance of having leaders with a wide skill set to support future career aspirations. Our programme has, therefore, been developed to provide a mix between leadership theory, regulatory focused application and general leadership skills development.

Who is your programme designed for?

This programme is for current leaders working in local authority regulatory services as well as staff members with the potential to lead in the future.

This programme can help Heads of Service that are looking for a way to develop their talented staff and support leadership succession planning in their services.

How long does your programme last?

The programme is delivered remotely over a nine-month period, so is suitable for a busy working professional.

There will be 36 hours of timetabled sessions scheduled to enable students to plan their diaries effectively. All other learning activities are flexible so can be undertaken at a time suitable for each student.

When will your programme be starting?

Our second cohort will start running in October 2021 and a subsequent cohort will run from April 2022.

Building collaborative and supportive networks is a key focus of our programme, so each cohort is limited to 12 students.

Who will be running this programme?

This programme will always be run by trainers that have experience in regulatory leadership.

We will also be welcoming guest speakers to our Masterclasses, so that students can benefit from a wider range of leadership experiences.
